ARTIST STATEMENT

I am intrigued by the space in between the dimensions. Through my art I explore this interstitial world and illustrate the magic that it holds for me. I create sculpture, installations, and objects that individuals can interact with and that affect their perception of the space that they inhabit. Experimenting with different materials, I search for new ways to understand the relationships between line, form, planes, and volume. By manipulating a string or a flat sheet into a voluminous form, I attempt to bring attention to the three dimensional world we live in and the ways that the forms that surround us inhabit the space.

I create sculptures and installations that integrate light, shadow and movement into spacetransforming artworks. The "Expanding Landscape Installation" is one of my pieces that illustrates this transformation. In the installation viewers are able to experience the sculpture from different angles, walking into the sculpture to be surrounded by the undulating forms. Made from simple materials of only Mylar and monofilament, the work alters a space with shadow and light. Inspired by alternative architectural methods, this sculpture is created by transforming flat two-dimensional materials into complex threedimensional forms. Slits in the flat material allow it to open up into a 3 dimensional shape.

The ideas of interaction, transformation and kinetics are at the core of my work with the goal of pushing boundaries between the dimensions and between different disciplines. My work addresses the complexities that lie in the in-between spaces: the tension between structure and fluidity, systems and chaos, movement and transformation, perception and reality. From my beginnings in jewelry design my practice has evolved to include sculpture and installations that explore many of the same concepts that fascinated me when I first began making miniature sculptures in the form of jewelry.
