ARTIST STATEMENT

My work is the exact and detailed representation of real or imaginary objects. Through academic drawing I expose the structure, fragility and relationship both compositional and symbolic of objects, as well as their interaction with other elements. I create images that take up the spirit of the illustrations of the old books of science, in which the naturalistic description is composed of aesthetic and ornamental elements, in this sense, transfer and broaden the intention of objects of common use, rethinking their function in diverse Contexts, giving rise to an alternative world to the mind and the senses. The structures and solitary elements that are represented autonomously, occupy a good part of my production; The consequence of an in-depth analysis through the observation and appropriation of images, recreating them in such a way that they may or may not be part of a series. Analysis both sensorial, by the way in which the essence, color, smell, shape, texture, and so on are captured; As well as rational by the execution of the technique. By achieving this, banal objects such as feathers, stones, leaves, branches and bones, among others, when interpreted through art, become the central axis of the work
