

## Jonathan Leach

#### ARTIST STATEMENT

I am concerned with creating a connection to abstraction and abstract painting/installation through a visual language that most of us find common. I then distort that pattern of understanding through formalist gestures, and generate a feeling of progress and exploration. The spaces and planes illustrated in my work are alive; they do not intend to rest.

My work has always taken influence from architecture and pathways that make up our urban environment. I am inspired by visual structures, systems, and signals that direct us through life. I am very interested in the abstract language that has developed out of urban planning and use that language in my paintings and sculptures. The work reflects this abstract language sometimes conveying a memory of familiar places and icons, such as parking garages, warehouses, car lots, and directional signs. These structures feel more expected in urban areas than trees, shrubs, and grass. They are the new organic, an innate aspect of our environment. The colors used in the work are bright and enticing like those used to seduce our wandering eye through public advertising and cautionary imagery. Fluctuating between harmony and dissonance, the colors also create tension and evoke vigorous exploration and movement.

Movement is a large part of my work. It is explored within the composition, indicated by directional symbols, lines of motion, and a dynamic angular understanding of the landscapes that I draw from. My multi-panel paintings and paintings on plexiglas are examples of breaking out beyond the framework of the canvas into something more sculptural, yet rooted in the language developed in my landscapes. The paintings on plexiglas cubes demand movement from the viewer as they experience the different sides of the composition blending together and changing while they circle the object. It is very important that each side of the object and each composition formed by moving around the sides of the cube animate a complex balance of form, color, line and composition. Unlike the canvas, the space created by these structures feels real, tangible and yet the two-dimensional application of paint to the surface, keeps the tension of the unreal at play and taut.

#### ARTIST ABRIVIATED BIOGRAPHY

Jonathan Leach is a painter/sculptor currently living and working in Houston, Texas. After receiving a BFA from The School of the Art Institute of Chicago in 2001, Jonathan has exhibited his work nationally, exploring the language of architecture, advertising, and traffic in his abstract works. Jonathan has had solo shows at Gallery Sonja Roesch, the Galveston Arts Center and galleryHOMELAND, created public sculpture in the form of a putt putt challenge incorporated in Discovery Green's "Insperity Golf Experience" project, and will be producing a large mural for the north wall of Lawndale Art Center in March of 2015. Leach's work was featured in the 2013 Texas Biennial. His work is also in the collections of NRG Texas, Hess Co., the Bank of Montreal, Hobby Airport of Houston, and the Museum of Fine Arts Houston. Jonathan is represented by Gallery Sonja Roesch in Houston, Texas, Cambia Art in Austin, Texas, and by Mirus Gallery in San Francisco, California.
