

## Dameon Lester

### ARTIST STATEMENT

Dameon Lester's objects portray subtle nods, or riffs, to the likes of minimalism, color field painting, interior design/architecture, culture, and nature. His objects take shape through the use of specific elementary materials, from pipe cleaners to plywood, that guide both the perceptions of the viewer and the aesthetic of the art. The employment of purchased, fabricated, recycled, and repurposed materials help lend the unique physical and formal qualities which evolve into an array of solid surfaces and open-celled, internal structures. Lester's organic and geometric forms blend loose social and art movement references together, creating guided allegories into the consciousness of our civilization for the viewer to personally expand.

#### BIOGRAPHY

Dameon Lester received his BFA from Virginia Commonwealth University, in sculpture, where he studied abroad at Loughborough College of Art and Design in the UK and Technikon Natal in South Africa. He received his MFA from the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, engaging with many internationally recognized artists and critics as visiting faculty. He later attended California State University, Los Angeles, for his teaching credential and to pursue his MA in Special Education.

Lester continues an active art practice, having received numerous grants, recognitions, and opportunities for more than a decade. He draws insight and perspective from many facets of life – including his past work with special-needs children and adults, and highly gifted art students at Otis College of Art and Design.

Since his relocation to Austin, TX, Lester has been establishing a new home-based studio and developing new work.
